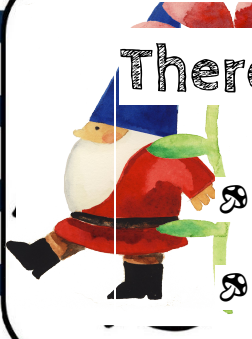

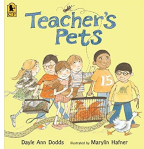

Dear Parents,

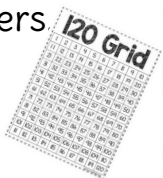

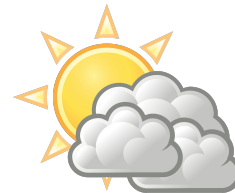
Math
